At the Chamberlin Family Foundation, we know it takes a robust ecosystem to provide our young people with everything they need to succeed. To help support this ecosystem, we provide community grants to direct-service organizations that make a difference for youth across West Contra Costa.

This year, we decided to extend our grantmaking reach to include organizations nominated by community members like you. We called on the West Contra Costa community to help us identify high-impact organizations that might align with our mission to support people and ideas that make a difference.

We could not have been more excited about our community's response! After a brief nomination period, we received over 70 nomination submissions from people across West County. We enthusiastically invited all eligible organizations to apply. A detailed review of capacity, alignment and potential for impact based on our [Community Giving Rubric](#) led to our final funding decisions for 2018.
